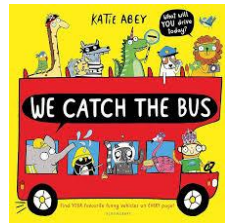

Communication and Language

- Enjoy listening to stories and can remember much of what happens.
- Sings songs

Physical Development

- Use one-handed tools and equipment, for example, making snips in paper with scissors.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Show more confidence in new social situations
- Begin to talk to new people more confidently
 - Talk about one of the rules we have in pre-school

Literacy

- Be able to find familiar letters e.g. letters in their name.
- Be able to talk about a range of familiar stories.

Expressive Art and Design

- Sing familiar Nursery Rhymes and Nativity songs.
- Use different colours and materials to make Rangoli Patterns.
- Make Christmas cards and decorations for friends and family using a range of media.

To make patterns with paint and different objects, exploring what happens when you mix colours. **(Art Link)**

Joins construction pieces together to build and balance. **(DT Link)**

Understanding the World

- Understand where their house is and be able to say their house number and name.
- Recognise different places that are on their road or that they see on the way to school e.g. shops, petrol station etc.
 - Know how to cross a road safely.

Maths

- Count out a group of up to 5 objects.
- To be able to match number of objects to numeral.
- Show an understanding of 1:1 counting to 5.
- Know that the last number you count represents the total number of objects.

Talk about and explore 2D shapes using relevant mathematical vocabulary such as flat/sides/
