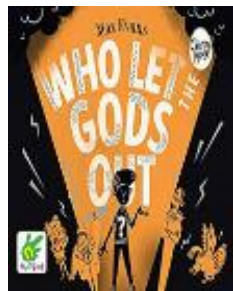

What do you think is the most important achievement/influence from Ancient Greeks on the western world?

How and why do things move?

This half term we are learning how to be a **physicist**. We will discover what their job and involves and how their work helps them to understand the way the physical world works.

As Historians we will be investigating the most important achievement and influences from Ancient Greeks on the western world. We will think about Ancient Greek democracy and how this shaped law order for humanity.

As Scientists we will be investigating forces including gravity, air resistance, water resistance and friction. We will conduct experiments to investigate these forces and draw our own conclusions.

As artists we will design sculptures (clay pots) to explore form and structure. We will use techniques and implements to add detail and create particular effects. We will also learn about Grayson Perry and his style of art.
