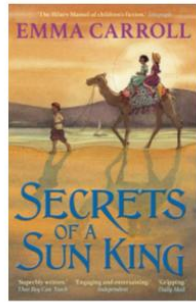
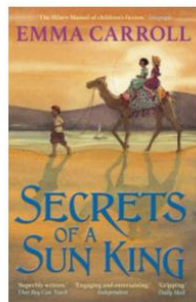
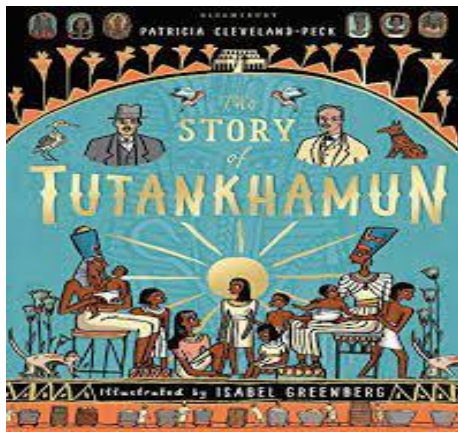

Egyptian Adventure Year 4 Summer 1

What was the most significant achievement from the Ancient Egyptians?

What was daily life like at different levels in Egyptian society?

This half term we are continuing our learning how to be an Egyptologist. We will discover what their job involves and how their work helps them to understand the way the physical world works.

In Religious Education we are looking at the concept of freedom and how rules can exist in different religions.

As Scientists we are exploring different habitats and the impact that humans can have on them.

As Artists we will be looking at Lino Printing inspired by Sybil Andrews using tools correctly to recreate hieroglyphs. We will be trying printing on to a variety of mediums e.g. card, wood etc.
