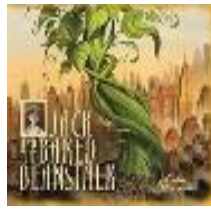

What is a habitat?

This half term we are being **veterinarians**. We will use our scientific knowledge of habitats and what animals need to design a shoe box home for an animal which meets all of their needs.

As **Scientists** we will find out plants, we will look at what they need to survive and the best habitats for them to grow in.

As **Geographers** we will learn about the continents and oceans of the world. We will look at the different habitats that you find in each of the different places.

As **Artists** we will explore the role of an illustrator. Using different painting and drawing techniques inspired by Colin Simpson, we will recreate a scene from Jack and the Baked Bean Stalk.

In computing we will be using our photography skills to take pictures of animals in their habitats and creating a digital media file.
