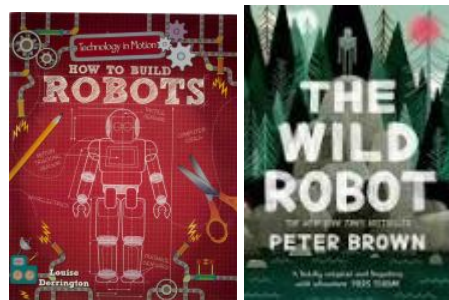

Rise of the Robots! Year 3 Summer 1

Why are 8 points of a compass better than 4?

What jobs would grid references and mapping be useful in?

This half term we are learning how to be an **Ordinance Surveyor**. We will learn about the importance of maps in rural and urban areas.

As **Geographers** we will expand on our fieldwork skills by learning about 8 compass points and grid references. We will explore how places can change over short and long periods of time.

Hook

Scavenger hunt around the school using compass directions for the directions. Use clues to help figure out a link to the topic or spell out a key word or phrase

As **Scientists** we will be learning about plants and how they pollinate and reproduce.

As **Musicians** we will listen to music and consider the narrative it could represent. Pay close attention to the dynamics, pitch and tempo and how they change.

Trips and Visits

We will visit Staunton Country Park to learn how to follow a compass and read a map to navigate around an unfamiliar location.
