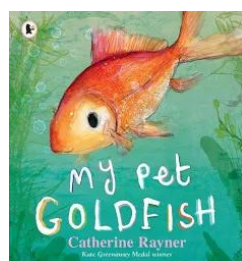
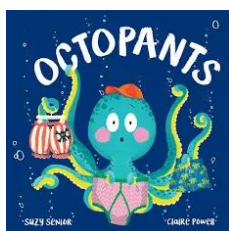
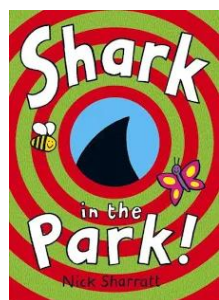

What animals live under the sea?

Communication and Language

- Builds up vocabulary that reflects the breadth of their experiences
- To join in with different nursery rhymes.

Physical Development

- Match their developing physical skills to tasks and activities in the setting.
- Start to eat independently and learning how to use a knife and fork.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Select and use activities and resources, with help when needed.
- Develop their sense of responsibility and membership of a community.
- Help to find solutions to conflicts and rivalries.

Literacy

- * Write some letters accurately.
- * Write some or all of their name
- * Develop their phonological awareness recognise words with the same initial sound, such as money and mother and clap and count syllables in a word.
- * Be able to orally blend words.

Expressive Art and Design

- Sing familiar Nursery Rhymes alongside playing instruments and follow the rhythm.
- To listen to music and create movements to the different beats.
- To construct with bricks and blocks to make an enclosure.
- Explore different materials freely.

Understanding the World

- Understand what animals live under the sea and how they are different to animals that live on the land.
- Notice similarities and differences between animals
- Shows care and concern for living things and the environment

Maths

- To count, order and recognise numbers to 10, in and out of sequence.
- To name and describe 2D shapes.
- To name some common 3D shapes and properties.
- To compare and order objects according to their size and distance.
- To show an awareness of positional language such as under/behind/ next to/over/ on top of.
